What is a Lifetime Powertrain Warranty?

So... what is the World Car Lifetime Powertrain Warranty* all about? How does it work? And what specific parts are actually covered under the warranty? These are very common questions that get asked about our Lifetime Warranty*.

First, let's **define** what a powertrain is.

"In a motor vehicle, the term **powertrain** or **powerplant** describes the main components that generate power and deliver it to the road surface, water, or air. This includes the **engine, transmission, drive shafts, differentials, and the final drive** (drive wheels, continuous track as in military tanks or caterpillar tractors, propeller, etc.). More recently in hybrid powertrains the battery, the electric motor and the control algorithm are also seen as elements of the powertrain."

A **Powertrain Warranty**, in the case of the World Car Lifetime Powertrain Warranty*, is **all of the greased and oiled parts** of the powertrain.

*This Excludes All Genesis Vehicles.



How does this all work?

This Lifetime Powertrain Warranty* from World Car starts to go into effect at the **end of your manufacturer's powertrain warranty**. It also **requires the same stipulations as your manufacturer's maintenance** in order for it to be valid.

What that means is that you need to make sure **you follow the recommended maintenance schedule**; keep up with **oil changes, tire rotations and recommended upkeep**. You do not have to get these things done at a World Car Dealership, **you just need to keep your receipts for proof of the service being performed**. Simply, as long as you are taking care of your vehicle, your Lifetime Warranty will be valid.

In addition, the Lifetime Powertrain Warranty* **does not transfer between owners**. If you sell your vehicle, your Lifetime Warranty does not go to them, **it only stays with the original owner** of the vehicle and once it is sold, no more Lifetime Warranty.

Quite a few people ask us,

"How much does this cost?" or

"We trade-in every 3 or 4 years, can you please remove the cost of this Lifetime Warranty so we can get a lower price?"

Well, the answer to both of these questions is that there **is no price added into the cost of the vehicle**. This Lifetime Powertrain Warranty* is **at NO additional cost to the buyer** of the vehicle. **Our pricing is 100% competitive** in the market with **peace of mind added at no charge**.

What specific parts are covered?

We separate the parts into 3 categories: **Engine Parts**, **Transmission Parts** and **Drivetrain Parts**. As we said earlier, these different parts in these categories make up the vehicle's powertrain.

With respect to the **Engine Parts** category, our Lifetime Warranty covers the following:

- cylinder block & heads
- all internal lubricated parts
- oil pan
- rocker covers
- valve train
- timing tensioner & chain
- front timing cover
- water pump
- fuel pump
- oil pump
- exhaust & intake manifolds (*including supercharger/turbo*)
- fuel injectors
- gaskets
- seals
- flywheel



What specific parts are covered? (Cont'd)

With respect to the **Transmission (or the Transaxle) Parts** category, the Lifetime Warranty covers:

- all internal lubricated parts
 - housing & cases
 - converter housing
 - torque converter
 - transfer case (*including internal parts, gaskets & seals*)
 - automatic transmission control module
 - clutch housing & converter
 - electronic transmission controls
 - automatic transmission cooler

Regarding the **Drivetrain Parts** covered with the Lifetime Warranty:

- gaskets
- seals
- bearings
- universal joins
- all internal lubricated parts
- propeller shafts (*drive shaft*)
- final drive housing

Now, that is **quite a list of parts**. Next we will go over some **frequently asked questions** (f.a.q.'s) regarding our **Lifetime Warranty**.



Frequently Asked Questions (F.A.Q.'s)

Q: What is the deductible?

A: There is no deductible for covered repairs.

Q: Which vehicles come with a Lifetime Warranty*?

A: The warranty only applies to brand new vehicles being purchased (*excludes all Genesis Brand Vehicles*). No used or certified vehicles are given this warranty.

Q: What's covered under the Lifetime Warranty*?

A: The components covered are exactly the same as the manufacturers Powertrain Warranty, plus any additional coverage that is listed on the lifetime warranty certificate provided when you purchase a qualified vehicle.

Q: How long is the Lifetime Warranty* really good for?

A: The Lifetime Warranty* is valid for as long as the original buyer owns the vehicle and for an unlimited time and for unlimited miles.

Q: How much does it cost?

A: There is no charge! The Lifetime Warranty* is standard with every qualifying vehicle and is an integral part of owning a vehicle purchased at any of the dealerships of the World Car Auto Group*.

Q: Is there any extra maintenance required to maintain the warranty?

A: No! You must simply follow the Manufacturers' Recommended Maintenance as referred to in the owner's manual for that qualifying vehicle.

Frequently Asked Questions (Cont'd)

Q: Does my maintenance/services have to be done at your dealership?

A: No! You are not required to come here. To maintain the warranty, you must have maintenance for the covered components done at a Licensed Repair Facility, according to the manufacturer's recommended maintenance and keep your records. It's that easy!

Q: Where can I get coverage under the Lifetime Warranty*?

A: The Lifetime Warranty* is good at dealerships and licensed service centers throughout the country in all 50 states.

Q: Is the Lifetime Warranty* transferable if I sell the vehicle?

A: No. The Lifetime Warranty* stays with the original owner.

Q: What's the catch?

A: No Catch! No hidden fees, no surprises, no gimmicks.
